I contacted Russ Olson from Impact regarding a laptop of desktop for you to use.

They do have several machines coming in early summer. They have a laptop device that would work for you and the cost would be right around \$200 however I'm reluctant to get it as all of their computer come with Windows 7 or 8.1.

Microsoft is going to no longer support Windows 7 in January next year so that would be out. This laptop loaded with Windows 8.1 would work for you and is going to be supported till January 2023. Doubt the computer would last that long.

That being said the machines are nearly 4 years old already. We have used them at the bank as machines that really don't get heavy use.
